I. Registration process

I. Fees of registration

a. CMAS Fees



For each round, in order to participate, each competitor is required to pay the CMAS fees fixed annually by CMAS.

• 25,00 € for participation fees by each round (for 2025).

Please note that the names of relay members must be entered during the registration process on the base of individual registration even if they only swim relay and even according to the rules, the composition of relays can be changed on site before the beginning of competition.

These fees will be paid only at the end of the registration process online, by credit card.

a. Miscellaneous

- Fees will not be refunded for non-participation of athletes in races.



- Penalties will apply for late enrolments after the deadline according to the registration planning.

c. Organisation Fees

2. Competition place

The swimming pool has a length of 50m, a width of 25 m and 10 lanes 25 m and ten lanes (according your swimming pool) and a depth of 2m. The temperature of the water is $26^{\circ}C$ (+ $1^{\circ}C$).

I. Timekeeping system

The timekeeper will conduct time recording through electronic time and recording system.

2. Classifications

Classifications will be based on times registered by the timekeepers, results will be complied according to CMAS score and CMAS World Cup classification.

- 3.1. There will be classifications for Individuals, Clubs, National Teams and Countries
- 3.2. <u>Individual</u>: There will be, for every distance, four different individual classifications for Senior and Junior, men and women. Swimmers registered by Clubs or National Teams are in this classification.
- 3.3. <u>Club</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior only registered by clubs). Four separate Club Classification will be made also for senior men, senior women, junior boys and junior girls.
- 3.4. <u>National Teams</u>: The general classification will be made by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior). Four separate National Teams Classification will be made also for men, women, junior boys and junior girls.

3.5. Countries Ranking:

- 3.5.1. The Countries' Ranking will be made following points 1.9 and 1.11 by the total amount of the individual points (men and women, junior and senior) of National Teams.
- 3.5.2. If a National Federation does not enrol its National team, the best two results by club following points 1.9 and 1.11 at each distance, at each category (men, women, junior and senior) will go for the Countries ranking.

3. Prizes

Individual prizes: medals will be given to the first three classified athletes in every individual race and every relay.

Teams prizes: cups for the first three clubs and cups for the first three National Teams.

Awarding ceremonies will take place during the competition, so the athletes involved must be at the organising staff's disposal at the right time.

During the award ceremonies the athletes must wear the official uniforms of their teams.

4. Antidoping

- WADA World Antidoping Code
- CMAS Antidoping Rules
- Athletes accept these rules as a condition of participation.

Responsibility

The Organising Federation, the organising committee, CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Chief Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition.

5.Additional Note

The schedule of the program can be modified according to the needs of the organiser's. Participating teams will be given all information regarding schedule changes.

Swimmers must be available for the Start Judge with their full equipment at least 10 minutes before the race starts.

6. Visa

Kindly note the following:

- I. An invitation will be issued to all interested clubs and teams to participate, and it will be available free of charge upon request.
- 2. A personalised team invitation, including all team member details such as passport numbers, can be provided free of charge upon request.
- 3. For teams and participants requiring a visa to enter the UAE, our team will handle the application process. The cost for each visa is €90.00 per person.

• The use of a snorkel is optional. Participants may choose to use one or not,

based on their preference.

• The use of the is not mandatory. Participants may use any type of fin, as long

as it does not exceed the maximum total of 55cm.











Detailed Explanation of Each Event in Finswimming, Categorized by Discipline and Equipment

I. AP (Apnea) Event

• 50m AP (Apnea) – This is a completely underwater sprint event. Swimmers use a monofin but must hold their breath (no breathing devices allowed) throughout the race. It's an explosive, high-speed event requiring maximum power and perfect breath control.

2. SF (Surface) Events

These events are swum on the surface using a monofin and a snorkel. Swimmers must stay at the surface and cannot go fully underwater except for starts and turns. Unlike Bifins (BF) events, swimmers do not use their arms for propulsion. Instead, they perform a continuous dolphin kick motion while keeping their arms extended in a streamlined position.

- **50m SF –** A short sprint (maximum speed).
- 100m SF A slightly longer sprint requiring both speed and stamina.

3. BF (Bifins) Events

These races use bifins (two fins instead of a monofin), and swimmers perform a front crawl-like movement with arms instead of the dolphin motion used in monofin events.

- **50m BF** A short and powerful sprint.
- 100m BF A longer sprint, requiring better energy management.
- 200m BF A middle-distance event with a balance of speed and endurance.
- 400m BF A long-distance event, requiring strong pacing and stamina.

4. Relay Events

- 4 x 50m BF Relay A short-distance team relay using bifins, where each swimmer covers 50 meters before passing to the next teammate.
- 4 x 100m BF Relay A longer relay using bifins, where each swimmer covers 100 meters before passing to the next teammate.
